



GOOD POSTGRADUATE PRACTICES AT THE IPN

Guide for foreign students in the postgraduate course of the IPN and for graduates of the postgraduate course at the IPN who will carry out studies in other national or foreign educational institutions

I. PRESENTATION

The purpose of this document is to facilitate the administrative processes required of applicants (or students) from other countries who will carry out (or carry out) postgraduate studies at the IPN. It also includes recommendations of formalities required of foreign students at the end of postgraduate studies at the IPN, as well as certification of curricula that other Mexican higher education institutions, or institutions from other countries, request as a requirement to postgraduate graduates of the IPN.

II. STUDENT TEMPORARY RESIDENT VISA APPLICATION

The applicant accepted in a postgraduate program of nationality other than The Mexican one, must accredit before the Mexican embassy or consulted, his acceptance within the framework of an admission process of a postgraduate academic program of the National Polytechnic Institute (IPN), for the purpose of applying for a Temporary Resident Student Visa. The student temporary resident visa accredits the legal stay of the person in the country for the purposes of carrying out formal studies within the National Educational System.

The interested person must go to the consular representation of Mexico that corresponds to him abroad. In addition, you can receive assistance in the process through the Directorate of Legal Affairs of the Office of the Advocate General of the IPN at the request of the higher school, research center or professional unit in which you are enrolled.

To prove their acceptance within the framework of an admission process of an academic program, the applicant must present to the consulate of their country of residence a letter of acceptance and proof of economic solvency for their entry into Mexico, in order to obtain the authorization of internment to the country. **To obtain the letter of acceptance to the graduate program, the accepted applicant must contact the academic coordinator of the program in question, providing the following information:**





- Copy of your passport
- Location of the Mexican embassy that corresponds to your current address,
- Postal address of the address where you will receive the letter of support to obtain a visa.
- Local contact telephone number

The coordinator of the program will prepare this letter, addressed to the Head of Foreign Affairs of the corresponding Mexican embassy, and will send it by post to the address indicated by the applicant. **In the case of applicants accepted into CONACYT programs, the program coordinator will send an electronic copy of the acceptance letter to CONACYT so that it can be channeled to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs (SRE).** The interested person must contact the consulate or embassy that corresponds to their domicile to arrange an appointment and go to an interview to apply for a student visa. The consulate will rule on whether or not you are granted a student visa. In case the visa is granted, the applicant must make arrangements for his/her trip to Mexico.

III. ARRIVAL AND ENTRY INTO MEXICO

The recommended arrival date will be specified by the program coordinator, but usually a suitable date is 2 weeks before the scheduled dates for the enrollment process.

Upon arrival in Mexico, the student must present their VISA and passport to the authorities of the National Institute of Migration (INM). The INM will provide a multiple migratory form (FMM) that is valid for 180 days to stay in Mexico, time in which the student must make the application for a residence permit to avoid sanctions and deportation.

The applicant must provide the information required in the application of the FMM, as it appears in his passport, also accept under protest to tell the truth, that the information and documentation provided is true, so it is made known that, in case of falsifying information, he could be sanctioned in accordance with the applicable legal provisions.

- For the FMM process, the applicant must have a passport or passport card (Passport Card) valid and in force in accor The Multiple Migratory Form can be obtained electronically through the INM web portal, foreigners who enter the country by land, through the places destined for the international transit of people.

- The applicant accepts that the condition of stay that will be obtained when entering the information will be that of visitor without permission to carry out remunerated activities.
- The applicant is aware that the FMM has a maximum validity of 180 calendar days and may use it for a single hospitalization.
- The applicant is aware that the validity of the FMM will be counted from the stamp of the migratory seal, as long as he/she accredits the requirements to enter Mexico.
- The applicant will print the MMF and must present it at the place destined for the international transit of people through which he intends to enter.





- The applicant is aware that the payment of the fee to obtain the condition of stay, does not guarantee his/her entry into Mexico.
- The applicant must present a valid and valid passport card or passport card, as well as the FMM at the time of applying for admission to Mexico.

IV. MANAGEMENT OF THE TEMPORARY RESIDENT PERMIT AND CURP REGISTRATION.

Once the applicant has his/her FMM and has been interned in Mexican territory, he/she must notify the Program Coordinator to initiate support procedures for obtaining the student's Temporary Residence Permit, as well as obtaining their Unique Population Registration Code (CURP).

To this end, the applicant must share a copy of the Multiple Migratory Form obtained by the INM during the process of entering Mexico.

The coordinator of the program will carry out the procedures through his Academic Unit with the Office of the Advocate General of the IPN to request the processing of the Temporary Resident Permit, providing the applicant with the date and necessary documentation to go to an appointment at the INM facilities. Once with a result of the processing of the Temporary Resident Permit, the INM will provide the applicant with a Unique Population Registration Code (CURP) and an FM3 card (Non-Immigrant Immigration Document).

V. REGISTRATION AS A STUDENT TO THE IPN

The applicant must submit the following documents, they must be delivered to the school control area of the Unit where once the FMM has been obtained, the applicant must attend the following formality for the registration process in the IPN: procedures necessary for the legalization or apostille of the following documents:

- Certificates of Qualifications, with apostille or legalization.
- University degree or Bachelor's Degree, with apostille or legalization.
- Equivalence of qualifications,
- Birth certificate or certificate, with apostille or legalization.
- CURP,
- FM3,

In the case of documents prepared in a language other than Spanish, they must be delivered accompanied by the official translation into Spanish.



VI. CONCLUSION OR INTERRUPTION OF STUDIES.

When the student concludes his/her studies or interrupts them, the higher school, research center or professional unit in which he/she is registered must notify by means of an ex officio the Legal Affairs area of the Office of the Advocate General, which is in charge of attending to the pertinent regarding the migratory situation of the same.

VII. SCHOLARSHIPS FOR FOREIGN STUDENTS

General requirements for the National Scholarship granted by CONACyT through the IPN

The IPN through the various graduate level schools and research centers, have registration of the National Quality Graduate Program (PNPC) of the CONACyT of its postgraduate academic programs and scholarships are awarded to national and foreign students who have been accepted within a Call for admission process.

Requirements for the application to the Traditional National Scholarship granted by CONACyT

- Be carried out by the administration of the school or research center.
 - Have a minimum average of 8.0/10.0 (for the equivalency of your country to Mexican system you can check:

 - Be a full-time student
 - Be a student enrolled in the school or research center
 - Have CVU
 - Have a FIEL signature issued on the SAT
 - No additional income issued by a third party
 - Open a bank account in BANCOMER under the instructions you request
- CONACyT
- Perform the steps of filling fields on the platform to conclude with the application status.
 - Read the scholarship regulations established by CONACyT
 - Make a report of academic performance each school period





The IPN, through the Secretariat of Research and Postgraduate Studies (SIP) and through the Postgraduate Directorate, offers scholarships for the postgraduate level. Only students of those postgraduate academic programs that do not have the registration of the National Quality Postgraduate Program (PNPC) of CONACyT may apply for a Study Scholarship or they may apply for a Thesis Scholarship of any postgraduate academic program, regardless of whether or not they have the registration in the PNPC, those students who have not exceeded the maximum deadlines, and who have not requested an extension of the deadline, to obtain the academic degree stipulated in the Regulations of Postgraduate Studies of the IPN in force at the time of publication of the corresponding call.

General Requirements for the IPN Postgraduate Institutional Scholarship

- Possess Unique Population Registration Code (CURP). Foreign students may obtain the CURP according to the procedure described in the following link: <http://consultacurp.com.mx/curp-para-extranjeros/>
- Be enrolled full-time and exclusively nominated by a professor with a postgraduate appointment in the Academic Unit responsible for the program
- Have obtained a minimum average of 8.0 in the last school period studied within the graduate academic program applying for your scholarship or, for recent students a minimum average of 7.8 at the level of studies immediately above

VIII. CALLS FOR AWARDS FOR THE BEST POSTGRADUATE ACADEMIC PERFORMANCE AND BEST POSTGRADUATE THESIS The IPN does not restrict participation in calls for the best academic performance and the best postgraduate thesis to students of the Institute with nationality other than Mexican, consult the calls that are published in the month of September in: www.posgrado.ipn.mx.

IX. AUTHORIZATION OF SPECIALTY, UNDERGRADUATE AND UNDERGRADUATE EXAMINATION Applications for authorization to take a specialty, undergraduate and undergraduate exam of foreign students must have attached the current documentation that demonstrates the student's legal entry and stay in Mexico.



X. CERTIFICATION OF STUDIES AND ACADEMIC PROGRAMS Certification of curricula For some countries it is necessary to submit the detailed curricula taken in the IPN for the purpose of local legalization of postgraduate studies. The IPN can issue certified curricula for this purpose by means of the following procedure in the following link: <https://www.ipn.mx/posgrado/servicios.html>

- The graduate must request from the high school, interdisciplinary or research center or professional unit where he has carried out his studies the curriculum to be certified and this must contain the following data: Name of the student Ballot No., Program (Specialty, Master or Doctorate), he studied Table of the subjects that course, with hours and total credit at 100%.
- The high school, interdisciplinary or research center or professional unit in which the graduate has completed his studies must prepare the document to be certified.
- The document must be sent by the graduate, and / or the high school, center interdisciplinary or research or professional unit by means of an official letter addressed to the Postgraduate Directorate (DPOS), in attention to the Division of Operation and Promotion to the Postgraduate (DOPP) and delivered in official office of parts of the IAPA, requesting the certification of the curriculum of the graduate before the General Secretariat (SG) of the IPN, attaching the following documents: Letter of application Curriculum Copy of the minutes of the degree exam or copy of the academic degree.
- The Postgraduate Directorate through the PDO will request the General Secretariat of the IPN the corresponding certification signatures based on Articles 4° section VII and 16th section V, of the Organic Law of IPN (Note: The signatures registered with the Ministry of Public Education (SEP), for certification of these documents are those of the holders of the Secretariat of Research and Postgraduate Studies (SIP) and the General Secretariat (SG) of the IPN. The time required for this part of the procedure is about 3 weeks.)
- Once the SG certifies the document, a response letter will be sent in a sealed envelope addressed to the high school, interdisciplinary or research center or professional unit for delivery to the interested party, or directly with the graduate, as the case may be.
- In case of signatures of authorities on documents of completion of studies (certificate and degree) These certifications are carried out in the Division of Postgraduate Support (DAP) of the Directorate of Postgraduate (DPOS), which make the request for certification to the General Secretariat.
- The interested party must submit an application in a free format in the IAPA parts office attaching the documents: Original Degree Original Certificate Format FR-SIP-7.1-0.02, available on the sites www.sip.ipn or www.posgrado.ipn.mx
- The corresponding area will review the file to, where appropriate, prepare the request for certification of signatures to the General Secretariat.





- Once the signatures have been certified, the documents will be delivered to the interested.

Preparation of certification of study documents These certifications are carried out in the Division of Postgraduate Support (DAP) of the Directorate of Postgraduate (DPOS), for cases of theft or loss of degree exam records or degree diplomas.

- The interested party must request the certification of lost or stolen documents, in a free format addressed to the head of the Secretariat of Research and Postgraduate Studies (SIP) of the IPN, delivered in official office of parts of the IAPA, attaching the following documentation: Copy of the lost document (only minutes of specialty, master's, predoctoral or doctoral examination, as well as specialty diploma, medical specialty, master's degree or doctoral degree) Denunciation of Facts before the original Public Prosecutor's Office and copy (for comparison) Format FR-SIP-7.1.0-02, available at www.sip.ipn or www.posgrado.ipn.mx

- The DPOS prepares the certificate of certification and transmits it to the more information to email alumnos.posgrado.ipn@hotmail.com with Ms. Fabiola Departure Kings.

Apostille of degree diploma, certificates and examination records

This procedure must be carried out in the corresponding office depending on the type of document:

- Documents issued in any state of the Mexican Republic must be apostilled in the General Secretariat of Government of each State.
- Federal documents must be apostilled by the Secretary of the Interior.
- Documents issued by AUTHORITIES OF THE CDMX MUST BE APOSTILLED AT THE ADDRESS General Legal and Legislative Studies of the Government of the CDMX.

XI. SPECIAL DOCUMENTS

Academic Program Continuity Letters

Some universities in other nations request official clarification that the master's degrees issued by the IPN are precedents for doctoral level studies. In these cases, the interested party must:

- Submit the application for the letter of continuity of studies, in free format delivered in the Official of parts of the IAPA and addressed to the head of the Postgraduate Directorate annexing the following:
 - Copy of the certificate of completion of studies issued by the IPN.
 - Copy of the master's degree diploma issued by the IPN
- After preparation, the requested document will be delivered to the interested party within a period not exceeding two weeks, signed by the Postgraduate Directorate.
