MODALITY OF THE PROGRAM: **SCHOOLED, TO START IN THE SCHOOL PERIOD 2023/1
(JANUARY-JULY 2023)**

UNDER THE FOLLOWING BASES:

MASTER'S REQUIREMENTS:

- Possess the official degree or certificate of completion of bachelor's degree studies, or equivalent document for applicants who have studied abroad.
- Approve the admission process established in this call.
- Accredited with a minimum grade of eight or equivalent, the level of knowledge of the English language or another defined and justified by the College of Graduate Professors, in two of the following skills: reading comprehension, listening comprehension, written expression or oral expression, or their equivalents; based on level B1 of the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages or similar, endorsed by the Institute's Foreign Language Training Directorate.
- Not have caused definitive withdrawal from any program of the Institute, by a well-founded and reasoned resolution of the Academic College, unless this has been revoked by said collegiate body.
- Degree in Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry, Oceanography, Engineering or related areas.
- Minimum average 8.0 at the bachelor's level.
- Present the results of the EXANI III exam (CENEVAL) with at least 1000 points (validity 2 years) or pass and exam of admission.
- For foreign students to submit GRE Exam results (valid for 2 years).
- Approve an interview with the Admission Committee.
- Cover amounts: admission process and English exam.

DONATION:

Admitted applicants must formalize their registration to the program without any mandatory payment, but with the possibility of making the voluntary contribution as a donation by opening the file to the account that is indicated by the corresponding academic unit. The accounts for collecting donations must correspond to the bodies of the National Polytechnic Institute authorized for this purpose.

The maximum number of applicants who may be admitted to the Master's Program in Advanced Technology will be 20. The study program is full-time. Tuition will only be covered by applicants who meet the requirements of the admission process.

REVALIDATION:

The program accepts the revalidation of master's studies. The purpose of the revalidation will be to accredit master's studies carried out outside the National Educational System to continue their master's studies in a program of the Institute. The CicATA-UA College of Teachers will analyze and rule on the learning units to be revalidated, whose number of credits will not exceed 48 credits equivalent to four learning units or 33% of the program. The Academic Secretariat shall determine, after obtaining the opinion of the corresponding University Of Profesores of Posgrado, the revalidation, where appropriate, of the studies referred to in the previous paragraph in accordance with the applicable regulations.
